


Tahano Venon


1. Introduction

Tahano Venon, or the "Beautiful Script" is a script traditionally used for embellishment. As the forms of the letters suggest, the shapes are reminiscent of vines. This script may look beautiful overall, but it is not really suitable for large amounts of text and it is not used for that in practice. Tahano Venon is a purely alphabetic script and can be written in any direction in fact. Also, the letters may be horizontally flipped depending how much space there is, except for the vowel letters A and E and their long counterparts.


